

2006 SWRHA Futurity & Show Conditions

FUTURITY CONDITIONS

- 1. Open to three year old horses of any breed.
- 2. There are seven divisions of the SWRHA Futurity Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro (50+). The Open division is open to any contestant. The Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro and Limited Non Pro eligibility will be based upon the Year 2006 NRHA Category 2 Class eligibility list. Each individual is responsible for his or her correct class eligibility.
- 3. Horse and rider MUST be nominated at time of entry.
- 4. Nomination fees plus judges fees must accompany entry forms.
- 5. Owner and riders must be current members, in good standing, of the NRHA. Copies of NRHA Competition License and NRHA membership cards for owner and rider MUST accompany entries. Both owners and riders must be members of the SWRHA to receive merchandise awards in each futurity division.
- 6. Discounts for the Futurity Classes For all Open classes, there will be a \$50.00 discount for each additional division entered. For all Non Pro classes, there will be a \$25.00 discount for each additional division entered. For all cross entries, there will be only one judges fee due. (Higher of the classes). Discounts apply to one horse/one rider entry.
- Entries MUST be RECEIVED by October 13, 2006 to avoid any late fees.
- 8. The draw will be completed *October 25, 2006*. Horses and riders entering after the draw has been completed will be placed in a group preceding the regular draw.
- Post entries accepted until 4:00pm October 26. A penalty of \$100.00 plus all regular entry fees will be charged for any entries received after October 13, 2006.
- 10. Divisions may be added or changed WITH OR WITHOUT PENALTY prior to 4:00pm on October 26. In the event division changes result in differences in entry fee requirements, no refunds will be granted, but any additional fees owed must be paid to compete.
- 11. There will be NO REFUNDS for Futurity entries.
- 12. Substitutions will be permitted with a \$50.00 penalty after October 13th.
- 13. For the Open, Int. Open, and Ltd. Open classes, there will be a first go and a finals. The number of horses taken back to the finals will be based on the NRHA placings per number entered (per NRHA payback schedule B) plus 5 additional entries. 25% of the purse will be paid in the go round, according to NRHA payback schedule B percentages and 75% of the purse will be paid in the finals, according to NRHA payback schedule B percentages.
- 14. For the Non Pro, Int. Non Pro, Ltd. Non Pro, and Prime Time Non Pro classes, there will be a first go and a finals. The number of horses taken back to the finals will be based on the NRHA placings per number entered (per NRHA payback schedule B). 25% of the purse will be paid in the go round, according to NRHA payback schedule B percentages and 75% of the purse will be paid in the finals, according to NRHA payback schedule B percentages.
- 15. Prize money for all division will consist of the respective total entry fees received, less a 50% retainage, plus the added money. All late fees and substitution fees will be added to the purse.
- All decisions of the judges are final. Three judges will judge the SWRHA Futurity with all scores being used.
- 17. All exhibitors will be subject to the use of photographers and videographers under the direction of show management for the benefit of show promotion. No exhibitor will be allowed the discretionary use of their services.

GENERAL SHOW CONDITIONS

- Ancillary class entries must be received by October 13, 2006. All ancillary classes will close 5:00PM the night before and the draw will be completed and posted at that time. Entries received after the draw is completed will compete in a group preceding the regular draw.
- Ancillary entries will be refunded if scratched prior to the draw. No refunds for ancillary entries after the draw is complete.
- 3. STALLS: Move in will be available no earlier than 1pm, Saturday, *October 21st* Stalls reserved only with payment in full, due *October 13th*. ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A STALL OR DAY FEE. If you want to stall with someone, all fees and reservations must be sent together. If reservations and monies are not received by October 13th, limited stalls will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Shavings will be available. STALLS ARE LIMITED! Paid reservations are critical. See Stall Reservation Form for details.
- 4. WARM UPS: Paid warm ups are available Sunday thru Tuesday. All futurity entries will be entitled to one slot per horse and each warm up MUST be ordered and pre-paid with entry forms. Absolutely no guarantees unless pre-paid. Sponsors will be given priority in paid warm up placement. For all other warm up reservations, please contact 580-759-2572. Reservations will be accepted beginning October 18th.
- 5. NSF CHECKS: All checks returned by the bank as insufficient, MUST be replaced with cash, money order or cashier's check, plus a \$25.00 service charge. If the payment was a futurity entry and the replacement money was not received by October 25th a late fee of \$100.00 will also be assessed. Any NSF not cleared up within ten days after the end of the show will result in immediate suspension from the SWRHA and the check will be turned over for appropriate action with the giver responsible for all additional costs incurred by the SWRHA.
- 6. MEMBERSHIP: Owner and riders must be current members, in good standing, of the NRHA. Current membership cards or a photocopy must be shown with each entry. Owners or riders must be members of the SWRHA to receive merchandise awards in each ancillary class.
- NRHA COMPETITION LICENSE: All horses competing in NRHA classes must have an NRHA Competition License.
 The original or a photocopy MUST be shown with all entries. No transfers will be handled at the show. NEGATIVE
 COGGINS ARE REQUIRED.
- 8. PAYBACKS: Payback monies will be made according to NRHA payback schedule. Show retainage is 50%.
